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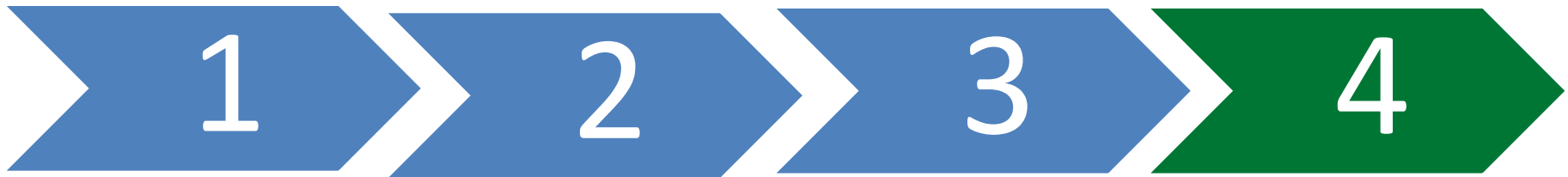


## Kenya SE4All Initiative BACKGROUND

- **Kenya opted into the SE4All process in 2012**
- The Initiative aims to **identify and mobilize stakeholders** from business, governments, investors, community groups and academia
- Ministry of Energy and Petroleum (MOEP) is the Focal Point
- The Kenya SE4All Process has been **highly consultative** and has involved other government agencies, private sector, academia and civil society organisations
- The Government has **two groups that steer the National SE4All Process**: The Technical Team (led by technical officer of MOEP) and a (wider stakeholder) Technical Committee

- 1. Official signing and political buy-in completed**  
SE4All AA and IP signed by both Cabinet Secretary and Principal Secretary for Energy
- 2. Official launch completed**  
Official national launch of the SE4All AA/IP – 2016 – all stakeholder categories involved

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

### 3. Regional East Africa SE4All Forum convened

Kenya Government with support from HIVOS planned and convened the forum.

- 80 participants attended from Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda and Tanzania;
- East African Community (EA) Represented; Forum Report Published.

**Objective:** To foster regional SE4All collaboration and experience sharing.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

### 4. National SE4All sensitization forums held

The National Government conducted workshops for all the 47 County Governments in Kenya (2015 to 2016).

**Objective:** Knowledge transfer on sustainable energy.

### 5. County Energy Planning Framework drafted

The National Government has, with support from GIZ, completed the drafting of this framework.

**Objective:** To cascade energy sector planning. Framework has been validated by County “Ministers” of Energy and nearing completion.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

## 6. National SE4All Data & Information Platform

The National Government has, with support from UNDP, launched the development of a new, all-inclusive national SE4All Data and Information Website.

- Will be managed by the SE4All County Focal Point;
- The process involves the national regulator, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC).
- Expected to be completed and fully operational in 2017.

**Objective:** One-stop comprehensive national platform on sustainable energy.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

## 7. SE4All Implementation and Monitoring Structures determined

**This comprises two levels:**

- (i) **National Level Secretariat** – Developed operational structures for SE4All at the Focal Point level
- (ii) **Regional Level County SE4All Committees** - Capacity support for forming county SE4All committees is planned to commence in June, 2017

**Objective:** Effective planning, management and monitoring of country-wide SE4All programmes and projects.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

### 8. SE4All Resource Mobilization Strategy completed

The strategy identifies processes for mobilizing funding for SE4All projects, and includes a resource mobilization forum and a marketplace for projects.

**Objective:** Timely resourcing of all SE4All actions in order to achieve the set goals.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

## 9. SE4All Monitoring and Reporting Framework Developed

The framework combines **nationally developed** (local) and indicators from the GTF

The framework aims to use as much as possible, **existing** institutional and operational reporting structures.

**Objective:** Effective sector-wide and cross-sectoral (nexus) monitoring, reporting and dissemination of results and lessons related to SE4All goals.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

### 10. SE4All Resource Mobilization Forum Planned

A resource mobilization forum is planned for May 2017. Requests for updates on projects in the Investment Prospectus have commenced.

**Objective:** To mobilize financial and technical assistance support for key SE4All actions and projects – especially those not addressed or are inadequately addressed by current finance flows and financing instruments.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

### 11. SE4All Budget Code established

The National Government has established a budget code for SE4All, thus creating an avenue for budgetary allocations to SE4All from the national treasury and to receive SE4All funds from development partners and donors.

**Objective:** To mobilize financial resources for SE4All and create accountable budgetary and funds flow channels.

# IMPLEMENTATION MILESTONES

## 12. IRENA Marketplace Linkages being explored

Kenya SE4All Focal Point and IRENA are exploring the possibility of linking Kenya SE4All projects and programmes to the IRENA marketplace. Links will likely be created between the Kenya SE4All Website and IRENA Marketplace.

**Objective:** To market Kenya's SE4All Programmes and Projects to potential partners and financiers in order to accelerate the achievement of Kenya's SE4All goals.



## Kenya SE4All Initiative

# Key Pillars towards SE4All realization

1. Renewable Energy Resource Assessment Study, covering all types of RE sources, has been completed for all the 47 Counties.
2. Kenya National Electrification Strategy (KNES) under preparation – identifies grid and off-grid areas and how to serve them. Draft has been subjected to stakeholder reviews.
3. Geospatial mapping – will assist in Country wide monitoring.
4. Multi-tier energy (access/demand) study ongoing.
5. Major energy access initiatives ongoing, e.g. Last mile connectivity project. More to be launched, e.g. US\$ 155m Kenya Off-grid Solar Access Project (KOSAP).

# IMPLEMENTATION CHALLENGES

1. Embracing the devolved level of government which came to being midway the SE4All process.
2. Inadequate funding for key preparatory activities, thus resorting to donor partners and CSOs.
3. Proposed operational structures yet to be made official.
4. National Energy and Petroleum Policy still a draft – County Energy Planning to be enforced under it.
