

- CEMG of great interest for all the Member States
- CEMG included in all national plans to complement grid extension to face access increase (140 to 450 M in 2030)
- Private sector involvement is desired
- “Mapping and assessment of existing CEMG experiences in West Africa” released: min. 271 systems, 91% solar, mainly grants, TIER 2 access
- SVI findings showing West Africa facing similar challenges as other regions
- Policy and regulatory framework being improved in all the countries, experience sharing
- Interest to advance together in the harmonization of the regional market (MEPS? QAF?)
- Different approaches to tariff schemes & different visions on role of public investment
- Appropriate energy planning, no CEMG in isolation
- Local manufacturing
